



About the Show

Eternal Melody comes to you from the Emmy-winning team behind Reconnecting Roots, where they just picked up a 2024 award for Outstanding Original Song. This time, their attention is focused on something that belongs to all of us - the music itself. Each episode brings together a legend like Dolly Parton, Jack White, Robert Plant, or Gladys Knight with a song that's stood the test of time, taken from the canon of the public domain. We record in Nashville's historic studios and wrap it up with a live performance in one of the city's cherished venues. It's not just about making another recording - it's about understanding why some songs never stop finding their way home.

In Good Hands

We begin with the artist's story, learning what drew them to this particular melody. These songs have been around the block a few times, gathering meaning along the way, and now they're finding new life in the hands of someone who knows just what to do with them.

Living History

Every tune carries its history like rings in a tree. We'll trace its path from the beginning, through all the voices that kept it alive, right up to today. It's our way of honoring where we've been and seeing where we're headed.

First Light

Our team meets with the artist to piece together a new take on the tune. The journey starts simple - maybe at a kitchen table or in a quiet room where the artist first sits down with the song. We're there for those first moments when they start to see their own story in these well-worn melodies.

The Bones

Our music team builds the foundation first, creating something solid that honors both the past and present. It's careful work, making sure the ground is steady before the artist brings their voice to the mix.

Sacred Spaces

Now the full song comes together in one of Nashville's historic studios—maybe RCA, Quad, or Ocean Way. Many of these artists have recorded here before, and we'll catch them as they bring their full heart to a song with history.

To wrap things up, each episode closes with a live performance, filmed during a one-night-only event at a legendary Nashville venue—like the Ryman, the Opry, or Bluegrass Underground. All of our artists will perform the song they've reimagined, sharing the stage and bringing their tunes to life in front of a live audience. Later, we'll edit this special show so each episode features the artist's live performance of their chosen song. It's one unforgettable night, crafted into moments that celebrate each song, one episode at a time.

Eternal Melody is a gathering of voices, paying tribute to songs that made them who they are and showing why these melodies deserve to be sung, again and again.
